Dear Friend of CRTC,

The Citizens Regional Transit Corp. (CRTC) is a grassroots 501c3 organization which advocates for an expanded Metro Rail. One immediate proposal is to expand Metro Rail for 1.2 miles as a loop into the Cobblestone District, along South Park Avenue, Louisiana Street and Perry Street.

The CRTC Board met with an engineering firm, Stone Consulting, on April 3, whose engineers are prepared to produce an action plan, called a feasibility study, which lays out both the engineering specifics and the current financial costs involved with the project.

Enclosed is an outline of the feasibility study, along with a diagram of the project.

The feasibility study will cost \$9,750. As soon as the CRTC raises that amount, the study may begin and is expected to take three months to complete. The CRTC has already raised \$3,500 from members and friends.
