The Future of Metro Rail is Now

...summary of an article by CRTC President Gifford, 11-23-09.

Essential planning is happening now, for the future of Metro Rail in Erie County.

At their Board of Commissioners meeting on 11-23-09, the NFTA announced that the draft assessment from their transit consultants will be ready for review in January, 2010.

New Federal transportation legislation was introduced in March (in the Senate) and in June (in the House). Action is expected in 2010, after Congress completes health care legislastion

The release of the TMD study by the NFTA plus the next Federal transportation bill plus the next set of data from the national census all taken together point to a pivotal moment.

Buffalo-Niagara is poised to either build on the assets of its existing light rail line within densely-populated urban areas, or to follow the lead of those developers whose 20th-century mindset requires automobile parking at every destination.

Now is the moment.

Let's craft a regional vision for all transportation modes.
