

What does it take to move 1000 people?


1 train (eight carriages)



15 buses




Anywhere from 250 to 1000 cars



This would then require 3.4 acres of parking space in the Sydney Central Business District.


Transit Provides more Capacity

 growth



We Need to Find New Ways to Fund Transit

Local and State Solutions

- Tax Incremental Financing
- Dedicated local taxes for transit
- Apply parking fees to fund transit
- Ballot initiatives where needed
- Increase State tax support

National Solutions

- Raise Federal gas tax (indexed to inflation)
- Advocate for Improved transit funding in Federal Transportation Act (current act expires Sept 2013)
