 - More frequent, more reliable, more convenient
 - Mobility justice
- Establish stronger financial foundation for transit
 - State:
 - Maintain STOA and Metro Rail Capital Commitment
 - NYS join TCI legislation*
 - Repeal NYS Stock Transfer Tax Forgiveness
 - Federal:
 - Follow-on CARES act*
 - Infrastructure bill for transit investment
- Expand Metro Rail
 - Amherst, DL&W,
 - Eastside / Airport
 - Work with Cornell "High Roads" fellow to document Eastside extension potential
- Expand Niagara Falls Trolley to Buffalo
